## Membership Opportunities

The Clay County Foundation recognizes all individuals and entity that contributes \$500 or more and becomes a lifetime member of the Foundation. As a member, you will be invited to attend the annual Clay County Foundation meeting.

## Development Categories

The Hospital Foundation has established three types of development categories: endowment fund, long term fund, and unrestricted fund. Regardless of which development category donor's give under, they can be assured that their gift will be administered according to their wishes.

### Endowment Fund

Permanent endowment fund from which only the earnings will be used. A donor's contribution to the endowment fund will remain in the endowment in perpetuity. The interest or earnings from the donor's contribution is the only portion that can be used for a specific purpose to be determined by the donor or board of trustees.

### Long Term Fund

A long term fund primarily for the facilities and major items of equipment. A contribution to the long term fund ensures that a donor's contribution is spent on long term, major item needs such as a construction project or a large piece of equipment.

### Unrestricted Use Fund

Unrestricted gifts to the foundation will be used in a manner that best supports the mission of the foundation. Unrestricted gifts give donors the opportunity to give to the cause of community healthcare without having to specify how their contribution is used.

### GIFTS OF CASH

Cash gifts can be designated by the donor to be applied towards the endowment, long term, or restricted use fund.

### GIFTS IN KIND

Gifts in Kind are contributions of products or services. The donor receives recognition equal to the dollar value of the in-kind gift.

### MEMORIALS & TRIBUTES

Memorials and Tributes are ways to honor the memory of a special person, or pay tribute and say thank you.

### GIFTS OF REAL ESTATE, OTHER ASSETS

Real estate, appreciated securities, works of art, jewelry or other assets can be sold or invested for the long-term benefit.

### PLANNED GIFTS

Special tax incentives are available for people who make carefully considered deferred gifts through estate plans. Life insurance plans can also benefit the Foundation efforts.
