LITTLE SNOWFLAKE, YOU'RE ONE OF A KIND

In Tennessee where I grew up, snows were infrequent, so if it snowed, it was an exciting event! I can remember going outside at recess at school and literally dancing around in the snow, sticking out my tongue to catch the snowflakes. Oh, that cold, icy treat!

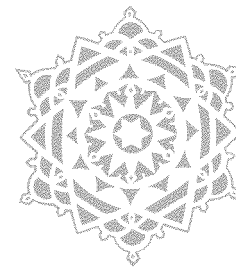
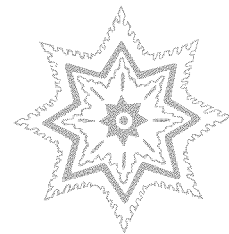
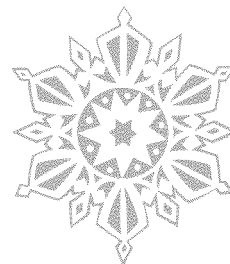
I also remember making snow ice cream from a fresh snow and the brain-freeze from eating the snow ice cream quickly before it melted. Snow ice cream still brings back pleasant memories. It probably took thousands of snowflakes to make one pan of snow ice cream, but I never thought about what a tiny snowflake might look like if magnified.

But there was a young man named Wilson Bentley who was curious enough to develop a way to magnify and photograph snowflakes. Mr. Bentley was born on February 9, 1865, in Jericho, Vermont, and he spent his life studying snowflakes. He became interested in looking at snow crystals up-close after his mother gave him an old microscope when he was fifteen years old. In 1885, after much trial and error, he became the first person to photograph a magnified snowflake.

During his lifetime, he photographed over 5,000 snowflakes and became known as "Snowflake Bentley." He died of pneumonia on December, 1931, on his farm in Vermont after walking six miles in a blizzard to photograph more snowflakes! Mr. Bentley left behind a large collection of photographs of snowflakes, and because of his work, we have learned some facts about snowflakes.

His photographs show that each snowflake has six sides with almost an infinite number of possible variations. Snowflakes are formed from moisture droplets from clouds when the air temperature is 32 degrees or colder. Air currents, the moisture content of clouds, and the air temperature influences the size, shape, and what a snowflake will look like.

The largest snowflake recorded in the Guinness Book of World Records fell at Fort Keogh, Montana, on January 28, 1887, and was 15 inches wide and 8 inches thick! A magnifying glass was not needed to view that snowflake!



The shapes of snowflakes are delicate, intricate. Snowflakes are not always totally symmetrical, and no two snowflakes are identical in shape and size! Each snowflake has its own characteristics and beauty, and each snowflake is totally unique.

Like snowflakes, it would be difficult to ever find two people who are just exactly alike. We come in all shapes and sizes, from different nationalities, different backgrounds, and different personalities.

Just as a snowflake has six sides, we too have some similarities—two eyes, two ears, one mouth, two legs, two arms, etc. But overall we are probably more different than similar.

We have different voice patterns and different DNA. We have different fingerprints—fingerprints that begin forming before we are born. Even Siamese twins have different fingerprints! Even if our fingerprints are burned off, they will grow back the same. Our fingerprints help identify who we are!

We have different talents, different likes and dislikes, our own idiosyncrasies and talents. Our physical characteristics vary from person to person—different colored eyes, hair, skin, and facial features. We respond to stress in different ways. Sometimes we respond to stress in the same way as our parents, and sometimes we respond totally differently! We are individuals—we are unique!

At some point in our life, we will all experience the death of someone we love. But like snowflakes and people, grief experiences may have some similarities and differences. Each of us is unique, and the time table for healing may vary, depending on the relationship with the one who died, the nature of the loss, and the age of the person who died. If someone you know seems to move through the grief process faster, slower or differently from you, perhaps they are grieving in ways that are normal for them.

If you are grieving, just remember those beautiful individual snowflakes! You too are a beautiful individual in your own right. There are no rights or wrongs on how to grieve. Each person's grief journey is still just a little different—none are exactly alike. *Little Snowflake, you are*

one of a kind! May your grief journey guide you to hope and to a fulfilling life!
